Building A New Place To Belong

One of the marvelous things about community is that it enables us to welcome and help people in a way we couldn't as individuals.

Jean Vanier

As a society we have come a long way from segregated and institutional living generations. Children with disabilities are now included in our daycares and schools, but once they reach adulthood, the opportunity for inclusion in work and social communities is still greatly diminished. Where can they find belonging?

The answer to that question is L'Arche, a place where people with developmental disabilities, and those who support them, live in stable, secure and affordable homes. For almost 50 years, our building on Sussex Ave. has enabled us to live a rich model of shared life and welcome the larger community into a place of belonging.

However, we are now faced with the realities of aging infrastructure, inaccessibility and changing needs that require L'Arche to diversify the way in which we support people.

There's an urgent need for individuals with developmental disabilities to have a broader choice of support models. Affordable housing is another serious issue facing many people with and without developmental disabilities today.

That's why L'Arche is planning a new, fully accessible building that will provide more options for those with developmental disabilities, and a unique design that will create affordable housing suites for people who wish to be part of an intentional, faith-based community.

Taking advantage of our existing property, L'Arche will replace the building with an innovative three-storey structure. The major components of the new building will include:

- Three new, fully accessible L'Arche homes for people with developmental disabilities and those who assist them, replacing three existing homes.
- Expanded space for community inclusion programs to welcome additional people into these programs.
- 10 units of housing as new models of support for adults with developmental disabilities who can live more independently.
- 29 units of affordable rental housing for those who wish to be part of our intentional community.
- Fully accessible meeting spaces that can adapt to various models.

In a large city where many people feel isolated and alone, L'Arche will continue to be a valuable asset in our neighbourhood by being a place of belonging.

We All Belong Campaign

Project Cost & Funding Goal

The **We all Belong Campaign** is well underway with 50% of the \$30 million project cost secured through the support of BC Housing, the City of Burnaby and many generous donors who have already come forward. We have raised \$2.5 million of our initial fundraising goal of \$5 million. Our hope, however is that by raising as much as \$15 million we can be debt-free when we open our doors in 2022.

Our new building, built on our existing site, will be fully accessible with two elevators and a covered entrance.
