Every month, at L'Arche, we highlight one of our ten core values that guide the way we live and work as an intentional community.



In **April**, as the world was dramatically changing due to COVID-19, it was appropriate to focus on **Trust in God** as our core value. It reminded us to seek and celebrate spiritual meaning in our day-to-day life.

To keep everyone safe and still be able to have our weekly community prayers, we transitioned from in-person to virtual prayer gatherings using Zoom.

Fulfill Your Role in Community, our core value for **May**, was a reminder to emphasize the importance of our respective roles in the community and to live them well. The commitment and dedication of our personnel, particularly the assistants in our homes has been phenomenal. They are among the frontline and essential service workers, in whose honour people across the city honked their horns at 7PM every day, early on in the pandemic.



In **June**, we focused on our core value, **Shape a More Human Society**.

This value is about sharing the vision and spirit of L'Arche beyond our community and helping to change the world. It is wonderful to once again hear our halls ring with noise and laughter. We continue to take all precautionary measures to ensure the health and safety of everyone.

Journey Together with Respect was our core value for **September**. Caring about how our actions affect others is part and parcel of what makes a community like L'Arche thrive.

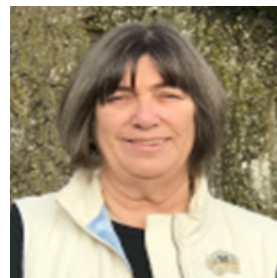

It has been a busy summer for some of our L'Arche homes with core members and assistants relocating from our main building on Sussex Avenue, in preparation for demolition. Barb and Theresa moved to a beautifully renovated accessible space in Nazirah house.

Creation House will be moving to a new house we purchased nearby, which is undergoing renovation to make it fully accessible. Securing this new home for L'Arche supports both our short-term relocation needs and our long-term strategy for growth.

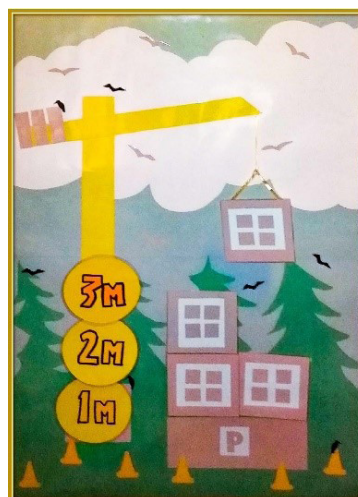
Relocation of administration offices and the community inclusion day programs is still in process.

This exciting project has a projected cost of \$22M. We are grateful for the incredible support from the local and provincial governments. Their provisional commitments of \$7.1M, combined with long-term financing of roughly \$9M, will make it possible for us to build this new home for L'Arche.

Our **We All Belong Campaign** is well positioned to raise

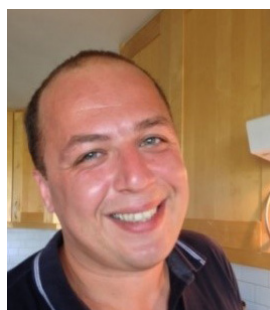


We All Belong fundraising thermometer by L'Arche artist, Alex Richmond

the remaining funds needed to meet the overall cost of the project. We have raised 50% of our **campaign goal of \$6M** and are relying on the philanthropic support of individuals and organizations to **help us raise the remaining \$3M by March 31, 2021.**

With your contribution, more people in our city will be able to experience community and a place of belonging through L'Arche.

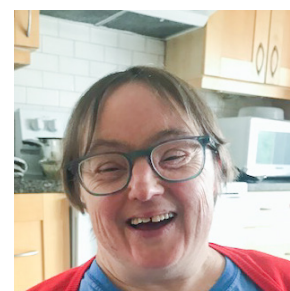
We believe our new building will be a legacy that allows L'Arche to share our collective vision that all people are deserving of love, compassion, and belonging.
